

THE "PONTESBURY POTTER"

A mountain and valley trail of about 13 miles for RUNNERS and RAMBLERS through the best scenery in Shropshire.
SATURDAY 14th March 2009

- START and FINISH** Mary Webb School Pontesbury SY5 0TG. Approx. 8 miles West of Shrewsbury. Follow Parking instructions on the day and do not obstruct local homes/businesses.
- START TIME** Anytime between **8.00am-10.00am**. *Note new registration times*
- ROUTE** A new route every year which follows lesser known paths and tracks and is only disclosed by following the detailed instructions issued at the start. Route confirmation markers are provided to keep you on track. Map reading is not required.
- FACILITIES** Toilets will be available at the start/finish and a Refreshments stall will be provided by Pontesbury Guides, Rangers and Scouts.
- EQUIPMENT** Wind and waterproof outer clothing. It will be significantly colder on the hilltops than at the start. Strong walking boots or fell shoes. Carry food and drink for anticipated time out plus some extra just in case. Carry a First Aid kit.
- RULES** Participate as individuals, pairs or larger groups. **No dogs.** Observe the Country and Highway codes. Report to the finish even if retiring
- ENTRY FEE** **£8-00** in advance, which includes pottery memento. Entries will accepted up to 1st March but will not be eligible for a pot if received after 20th February.
- CHARITIES** Severn Hospice and Shropshire Health for Africa Project (SHAPE)
- CANCELLATION** Entry fees may be returned if cancellation is notified prior to 7th March 2009. The organiser reserves the right to cancel the event for reasons of safety due to severe weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances. Entry fees will not be returned but will be donated to the charities as stated.
